

# Instant Eyebrow Tint Instruction sheet

## Color Capsules

For professional use only

Contains Resorcinol and Phenylenediamines.

Rinse eyes immediately if product comes into contact with them

Can cause an allergic reaction

Wear suitable gloves

Eyebrow Tint colorants can cause severe allergic reactions. Temporary "black henna" tattoos may increase your risk of allergy. Do not color your hair if: you have a rash on your face or sensitive, irritated and damaged scalp, you have ever experienced any reaction after coloring your hair, you have experienced a reaction to a temporary "black henna" tattoo in the past. Avoid contact with eyes. Rinse eyes immediately if product comes into contact with them. Rinse Eyebrow Tints well after application. Recommend wearing gloves while handling product. This product is not intended for use on persons under the age of 16. Keep out of the reach of children. Read and follow the instructions in the product leaflet carefully.

WARNING FOR AUSTRALIA AND NEW ZEALAND: This product contains ingredients which may cause skin irritation to certain individuals, and when used for eyelash and eyebrow tinting may cause injury to the eye. A preliminary test according to the accompanying directions should be made before use. IF IN EYES WASH OUT IMMEDIATELY WITH WATER.

## Hydrogen Peroxide solution (Developer (Oxidant)-Emulsion)

CAUTION: Contains hydrogen peroxide. Avoid contact with eyes. Rinse eyes immediately if product comes into contact with them. Recommend wearing gloves while handling product. Keep out of the reach of children. Protect from direct light and store in a cool place. Follow the instructions.

Prior to using kit, read instructions carefully.

Perform an allergy test 48 hours before applying to eyebrows.

## Alleray Test

- Prepare a small test solution by mixing a small amount of color and equal amount of developer (oxidant).
- Apply a light coat to the inside of your arm. Let the area dry naturally. Do not wash for 24 hours. If any redness or irritation occurs, wash the area with soap and water and do not use this product.

Helpful tips before you begin

- · Have a clock or a timer by your side for accurate processing times
- · Remove any color residue from the skin immediately to prevent staining
- · Use a lighted, magnified mirror

### TINTING THE EYEBROWS

Preparation

Wash eyebrows with soap and water and pat dry. Apply a thin layer of petroleum jelly or Vaseline around the eyebrows. This will prevent accidental staining of the skin.

- 1. Mixing the brow tint
- · Open capsules by separating ends and pour entire contents into the enclosed mixing cup.
- Pour an equal amount of crème developer (oxidant) into mixing cup (about 1/4 teaspoon or 1.25 mL).
- · Using wooden sticks, mix powder and liquid until a creamy consistency is reached.
- Apply the color

It is best to tint one brow at a time, allowing the color to process completely before starting the second eyebrow.

- Using the pointed end of the wooden stick, carefully apply the color to the eyebrow, making sure each hair is completely saturated.
- 3. Processing the color

# IMPORTANT: Processing times may vary. If your eyebrows are fine and light, the color may process more quickly.

Decrease the processing time by half and examine results. If you want to go darker, reapply remaining mixture and process another 30 seconds or more.

Processing Time

Jet Black = 3 to 4 minutes

Natural Black = 2 to 3 minutes

Graphite = 1 to 2 minutes

Medium Brown = 1 to 2 minutes

Light Brown – 1 to 2 minutes

- Once processing time is complete, remove color from area with a damp paper towel. This will stop the color process. Brow color will appear darker when wet. Allow brows to completely dry before examining results.
- If desired results are achieved, proceed with second brow. If you wish to obtain darker results, reapply mixture and process another 30 seconds or more.
